Dear Elma:

Just got through reading your dear letter
for the third time, that I received as I came
home tonight, well Elma it is now past
my bed time but you know that I can't
go to bed without sending a good night kiss
to you, which I think you will get for Thursday
night when Jessie is there again to see Marie
you just tell Marie that she aint the only
one that can get a kiss, for here is a big
sweet kiss Elma  and if she dont believe
it show it to her that you got one from me for
Thursday night, well Elma we had school tonight
and it is about 9:15 now but we don't care at
least I don't care Elma only I wish you were here
then I would care about going to bed don't you think
or Elma, then I would never get to bed last I would
be the first out in bed all the time Elma I would
bed you to bed all the time and be there waiting
for you to come to bed (and how) with a big kiss to
meet you, well Elma it simply looks as though I
can't write straight across these sheets when I
sit in my rocker with my feet propped on another
chair and writing away and scribbling at the
damn time

Elma I bet when you read that letter I wrote last night you think he sure writes as if there was something wrong with him writing such crazy junk like that, but Elma you know how it is a person feels kinda tuff and cross once in a while and then he is liable to do anything and especially when you are for yourself and nobody else to worry at that you can torment to satisfy yourself aint it so Elma or I guess it is a good thing that you aint here other wise I would be tormenting you Elma something terrible once in a while dont you think so Elma (and how would that be) you couldnt even begin to think what old J. would do to you Elma if you were here with daddy Elma wouldnt that be neal just think them daddy could his mama all the time, well Elma I will have to stop all this craziness and brace up and write something else, well we worked in town today and I changed 8 telephones and tomorrow we will also be in town for we are waiting for material to come from Duds for the Rural lines or telephone, the weather was real nice and warm today and a lots of snow melted so it aint so bad anymore, well Elma our Boss said again tonight that by the end of this month every telephone in Kokomo had to be Changed and he said the big Boss from Duds said it had to be done so that means some work till then, well that aint so bad after all, well Elma here comes lots of kisses and plenty love for all the times you get a chance to stop off and take one so dont get homesick for kisses, I am well and hope you are Elma **GOOD NIGHT ELMA X**
